First and foremost, we should focus
on why the victim's blood was blue.

What condition would you suspect first
if a patient's blood is blue?

Condition? Hm, a disease that
makes your blood blue, huh?

Oh. Methemoglobinemia.

[13:57] Takao

That's right.

[13:59] Sakurai

What kind of condition is that?

[14:01] Yu

It's a disorder where the hemoglobin in red blood cells get oxidized and turn blue,

[14:05] Yu

impeding the normal transport of oxygen.

[14:08] Yu

Symptoms include difficulty breathing and impaired consciousness.

[14:12] Yu

In extreme cases, it can lead to death.

[14:15] Naruse

So Kumade was inflicted with that disorder?

[14:17] Takao

To be exact, something happened to cause methemoglobinemia

[14:21] Takao

in the short hours between the shooting and his death.

[14:25] Naruse

"Something"?

[14:27] Takao

After shooting the rival gang's number two, he was hit by a bullet in return and fled.

[14:33] Takao

What would a guy like that do next?

[14:36] Sakurai

Seek medical help?

[14:38] Takao

That's right.

[14:40] Takao

Methemoglobinemia usually shows up as a symptom after being poisoned by something,

[14:45] Takao

but it can occasionally be caused by drugs like procaine and lidocaine.

[14:49] Naruse

What are those?

[14:51] Yu

Local anesthetics.

[14:53] Yu

Kumade showed signs of methemoglobinemia after receiving local anesthetics,

[14:57] Yu

and died from lack of oxygen.

[14:59] Yu

Am I right?

[15:00] Takao

Yeah.

[15:02] Sakurai

But Kumade didn't just suddenly die in a hospital.

[15:06] Takao

This wouldn't even be a case if he'd gone to a proper hospital.

[15:10] Sakurai

What do you mean?

[15:12] Takao

Kumade didn't have a normal injury. He was shot in a gunfight.

The bullet was still in his body.

[15:20] Sakurai

I see. He would've been found out if he'd gone to a proper facility.

That's why he had to go to a corrupt medical institution.

In other words, an underground doctor.

[15:32] Takao

Hachisuka Clinic is a clinic that caters to those in organized crime.

During the procedure, this man must have used a large amount of local anesthetics.

As a result, Kumade exhibited methemoglobinemia,

[15:48] Takao

and immediately fell into a perilous condition.

[15:51] Takao

But fearing others would discover he was an underground doctor,

he didn't take Kumade to a fully equipped hospital.

That's why he went to the

museum to continue treatment.

It had drugs that could treat him.

That's just treating the symptoms.

you'd need a medicine that turns
methemoglobin back into hemoglobin.

Good grief. You should know this
as a doctor of internal medicine.

Nope. This is what would have
saved him: methylene blue.

This aqueous solution
has a strong reducing effect

[16:50] Takao

that can treat methemoglobinemia
when taken orally or intravenously.

Hold on a second.

[16:58] Sakurai

Why would something
like that be in a museum?

[17:01] Takao

Methylene blue is also
used to treat pathogens

[17:04] Takao

that cause white spot disease
and water mold on fish.

[17:08] Sakurai

Fish?

[17:10] Takao

You know a lot about tropical fish.

[17:13] (Flashback) Takao

Yellow tang, blue tang, bluestreak
cleaner wrasse, carpenter's flasher wrasse.

[17:17] (Flashback) Hachisuka

Huh? Tropical fish?

[17:20] Takao

You realized a museum that takes care
of so many fish must have methylene blue.

Put yourself in this guy's shoes.

[18:03] Takao

If the body had been left as it was, it would've
been obvious he'd received medical help.

[18:08] Takao

He severed the leg with the
bullet wound to hide the evidence.

So Kumade must have
been shot in the left leg.

But severing a human leg isn't easy.
