If they both get to 20  
points at the same time,

the one with the higher  
total score advances, right?

**[16:46] Shiki**

*Even if Mikuriya-kun only gets  
one point for a correct answer,*

**[16:49] Shiki**

*if I buzz in and answer correctly for  
three points, I'll take the lead.*

Koshiyama.

**[16:57] Mikuriya**

The next question will decide it.

**[16:59] Shiki**

Yeah!

For better or for worse, only  
one more player can advance!

*If I don't buzz this time, I could lose.*

*I have to be careful... but fast!*

Question.

April 5, 1722; January 22, 1905;

and May 15, 1932...

**[17:23] Shiki**

*Three dates?*

*They have something historical in common!*

**[17:26] Shibata**

*Economic booms, crashes...  
Something economical?*

**[17:28] Shibuya**

*Celestial events... Annular solar eclipses?*

*What's next?*

All of these were, specifically, what da—
