work is the horse.

Really? I like it.

Yeah, Pluto-chan has come up with carnivorous plants before.

I can see why you like it.

[04:19] Shi

Carnivorous plants...

[04:20] Ued

She's a designer, as well. Her best-known work is the poisonous frog.

What kind of snake only eats
a certain bird's eggs?

[10:13] Kan

A freaking gourmet?!

[10:14] Kim

It's fine! It means they're just that delicious.

[10:16] Kan

It's not fine!

[10:18] Miz

Incidentally, with its simple body shape,

[10:20] Miz

the snake can move, climb, and capture prey.

[10:24] Kan

The more I hear, the more that
thing sounds like it's cheating!

It looks like a dungeon.

It's not beautiful!

[14:26] Kan

And even though they're trying so hard,
the snakes still keep coming.

[14:31] Kan

The birdies really do take
after me! They're so brave.

[14:34] Miz

You mean insane?

[14:38] Kan

That's why I thought of a new bird.

Is it possible for me to present
something to the client?

Uh, sure.

The bird class is also always welcome.

[18:24] Kim

In my experience, most animals that eat plants or insects are tasty.

[18:30] Kim

The less muscle mass they have, the tastier they are.

[18:33] Kim

Yes, I bet this one's delicious!

[18:36] Shi

I... I see.

[18:39] Kim

That buff lion tasted super horrid.

[18:42] Hig

Most carnivores don't taste good.

[18:44] Kim

They're more tender if
they have less muscle.

[18:47] Hig

The slow animals tend to melt in your mouth.

[18:50] Hig

It's because they have more
unsaturated fatty acids.

SIGN Unsaturated Fatty Acids

[18:53] Shi

Speaking of, you know how a chicken's
breast and thigh meat taste different?

SIGN Breast

SIGN Thigh

[18:56] Shi

That's because they're
different types of muscle.

SIGN Tires Quickly

SIGN Doesn't Tire Easily

[19:00] Hig

The chest muscles have
explosive power and tire quickly,

[19:03] Hig

while the thigh has endurance muscles
that don't tire so easily.

Yes, it's capsaicin!

[20:05] Uma

That's...

[20:06] Shi

That's what makes chili peppers spicy.

[20:08] Shi

So it's just a spicy sausage!

[20:10] Hig

So good!

[20:12] Shi

When did you...

[20:13] Hig

These spicy sausages are the best!

[20:15] Uma

Jupiter-kun, capsaicin won't work on birds,

[20:19] Hig

so you should probably add some other poison.

[20:22] Kim

Oh, I guess.

[20:24] Hig

Well, let's think about it while we eat.

[20:26] Kim

Agreed!

[20:29] Shi

The flavor is just being
recreated from data.

[20:32] Shi

We should keep the food chain in mind, too.

[20:35] Uma

Well, then Jupiter-kun must
undeniably be at the top of it.

[20:39] Kim

It's really good!

[20:41] Uma

This is no good! It needs
to have more defense...
