and right now, your archenemy is me!

Now, bring it on! Here is  
your enemy! He is right here!

**[36:41]** ---

...and I am here!

**[36:46]** ---

Here I am.

**[36:52]** ---

Seras, shoot him.

**[36:56]** ---

Shoot him! Shoot him!

**[37:00]** ---

Search and destroy!

**[37:03]** ---

Search and destroy!

**[37:17]** ---

Doc made it too strong.

**[37:39]** ---

The Acht-acht! That's fantastic! I love it!

It's over, Major!

**[38:28]** ---

So... it would seem.

**[38:33]** ---

But hey... not just yet.

**[38:38]** ---

Is that... Is that what you are, Major?!

**[38:44]** ---

**[38:47]** ---

**[38:50]** ---

A machine!

**[38:54]** ---

Do not speak... in such... rude terms...

**[39:04]** ---

**[39:13]** ---

You are a freak.

**[39:16]** ---

No, I am not. I am human.

...and that is their will.

**[39:30]** ---

I am not a pitiful monster like Arucard,

**[39:34]** ---

who must continuously  
take into himself others,

**[39:40]** ---

using the currency of blood, to go on living.

**[39:44]** ---

Do not lump me in with that weakling.

**[39:49]** ---

As long as I have my will,

**[39:53]** ---

then even if all that I am is a brain,

**[39:57]** ---

floating in a glass jar of culture medium...

Even if all that I am are memory  
circuits in a giant computer...

...then I am human.

**[40:15]** ---

A living creature with the soul,  
mind, and will of a human.

And even if he may smile in  
the appearance of a young girl,

or kneel down in the form of  
a battle-hardened warrior,

full of sentimentality, he is a monster.
